  vide its decision dated. 12.09.2022 in WP(C) No. 8814/2022 St Stephens College vs Delhi University and
  others.
- College continues to follow the NEP, as adopted by the University of Delhi.
- The second Young Leaders Neighbourhood-first Fellowship programme ended on 30<sup>th</sup> of May 2023. 21
  participants from seven different countries attended the programme. The programme was conducted with
  the help and assistance of the Ministry of External Affairs, Government of India.
- College continues to be the institution of choice for several foreign universities. Meetings and visits were
  held and College has had fruitful engagements with Universities from Japan, the United States of America
  and Korea among other countries.
- In the sporting arena Payal Khatri from 3rd year English, an international-level shooter was a multiple medal winner including the prized World Cup and Championship Gold Medal. Sandeepti Singh Rao from 3rd year B.A Programme won the bronze medal at the BRICS tennis games. Anurag Singh from 3rd year B.A. Programme participated in multiple international swimming events including the World University games and World Cup Championships.
