ABOUT ST. STEPHEN'S COLLEGE

St. Stephen's College, founded on 1st February 1881, is the oldest college in Delhi. The College was established by a Christian mission from Westcott House, Cambridge University, with its humble beginnings in a small house in Chandni Chowk comprising just five students. Initially affiliated to Punjab University, it later became one of the three original constituent colleges of Delhi University, which was set up in 1922. The College has an All-India and All-denomination membership. The College encourages the development of a holistic and diverse personality, which is reflected in the student body demographics and in the ample facilities the College provides for this purpose – a fine library containing more than ninety thousand books, top-notch sports facilities, and wide, spacious classrooms that are steeped in an academic tradition that has been followed diligently for more than 130 years. There are several academic and cultural societies that enable students to participate in a wide range of activities such as debating, dramatics, mountaineering, film and music appreciation, social service, photography, electronics, and quizzing. The College awards a number of prizes to students each year for achievement in academic and extra-curricular activities. Scholarships and other financial aid are given to deserving students on the basis of need- cum-merit.

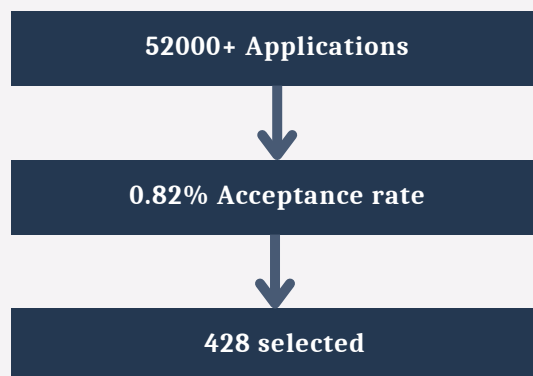

CONTACT THE PLACEMENT CELL

The Campus Placement Cell of St. Stephen's College is the sole body that is responsible for recruitments in College. We oversee the logistics involved in the recruitment procedure: The Pre- Placement/ Internship Talks, CV Submission, Management of Tests, Group Discussions, and Interviews associated with the placements and internships.

INTERVIEWS

The first step is to fill out the Placement Cell Questionnaire. This questionnaire will be sent to you once you contact the Campus Placement Cell either by mail or telephone. This questionnaire allows a smooth recruitment procedure and helps to ensure that the students have all the information required.

Companies/Organisations can then conduct a Pre-Placement Talk, the details of which (date, timings, etc.) can be worked out with the student placement coordinator. It helps the students to understand the company/organisation and job profile better.

Post the pre-placement talk, a newsletter is sent out to the students informing them about the opportunity. Post this, they are required to send their CVs to the Placement Cell, which is then forwarded to the company/organisation.

The companies/organisations may include a Group Discussion or a Test as a part of its recruitment process.

The recruiter can interview as many students as they wish.



RECRUITMENT STRUCTURE

The Campus Placement Cell segregates companies/ organisations through a two-tier system based on the Base Pay Package (BPP):

TIER 1: \geq Rs 10 LPA

TIER 2: $<$ Rs 10 LPA

The purpose of the Recruitment Structure is to minimize job offer wastage and at the same time ensure that all companies/ organisations get equal access to the talent at St. Stephen's College.

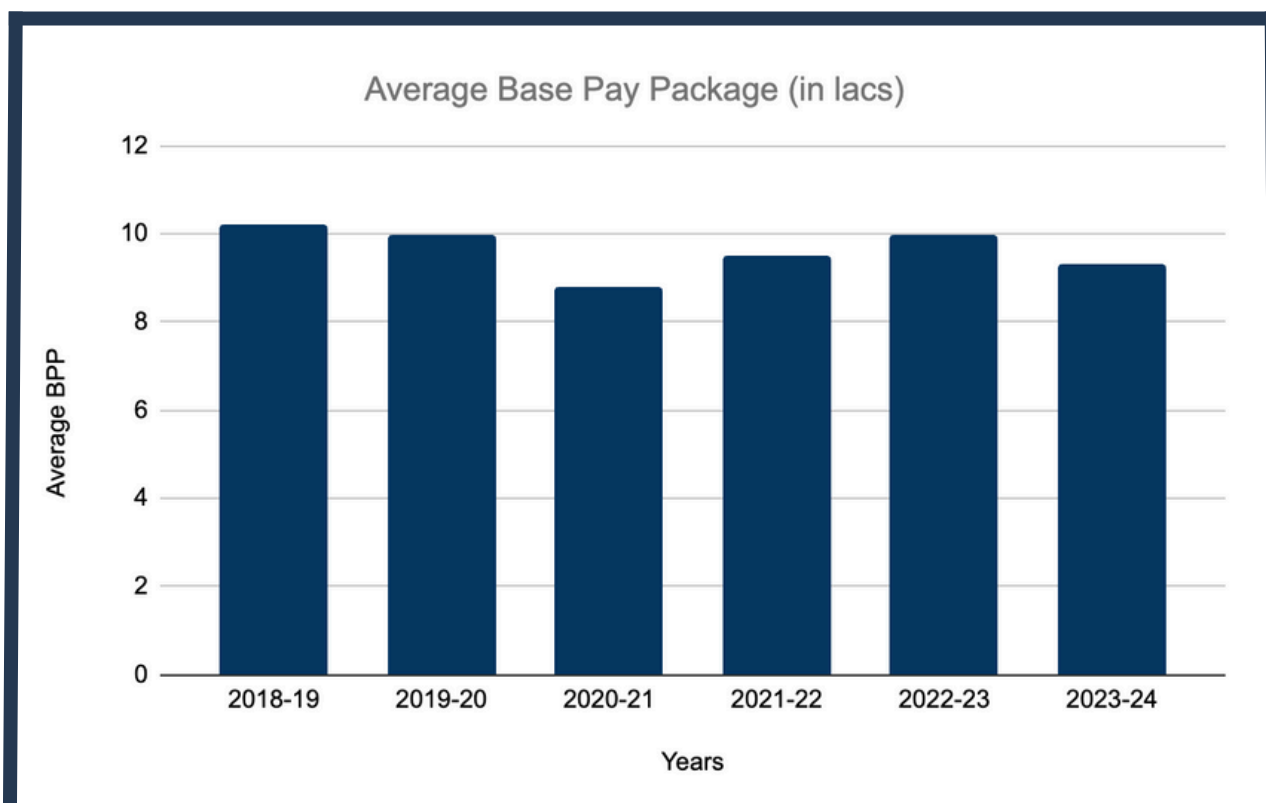
The structure is as follows:

I. A student with a final offer from a Tier-1 company is not allowed to apply for any new company/organisation and is out of all existing processes irrespective of acceptance/rejection.

II. A student with a final offer from a Tier-2 company/organisation can apply for a Tier-1 or a Tier-2 company/organisation. In case a final offer from the Tier-1 company/organisation is received, then the student cannot apply for any other company/organisation and is out of all existing processes irrespective of acceptance/rejection and if a final offer from the Tier-2 company/organisation is received, then the student cannot apply for any new company/organisation irrespective of acceptance/rejection but can continue with the existing process of a Tier-1 company/organisation if they are already in the shortlist.

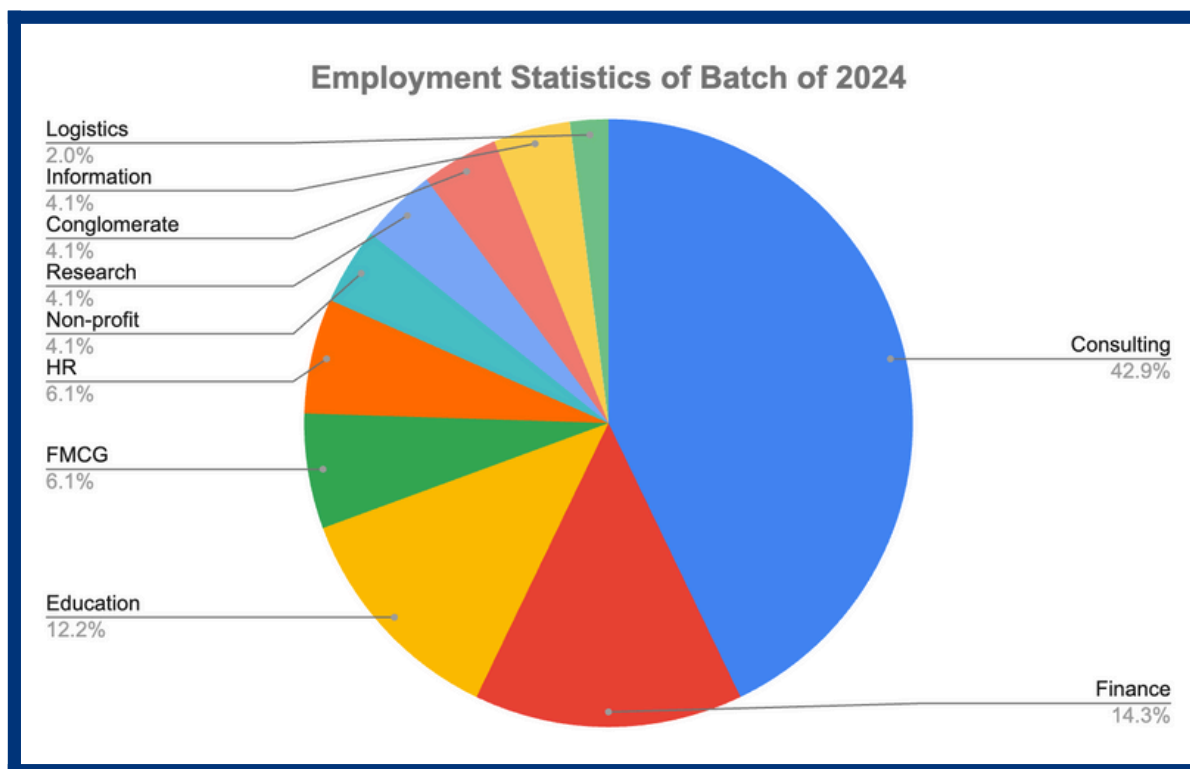

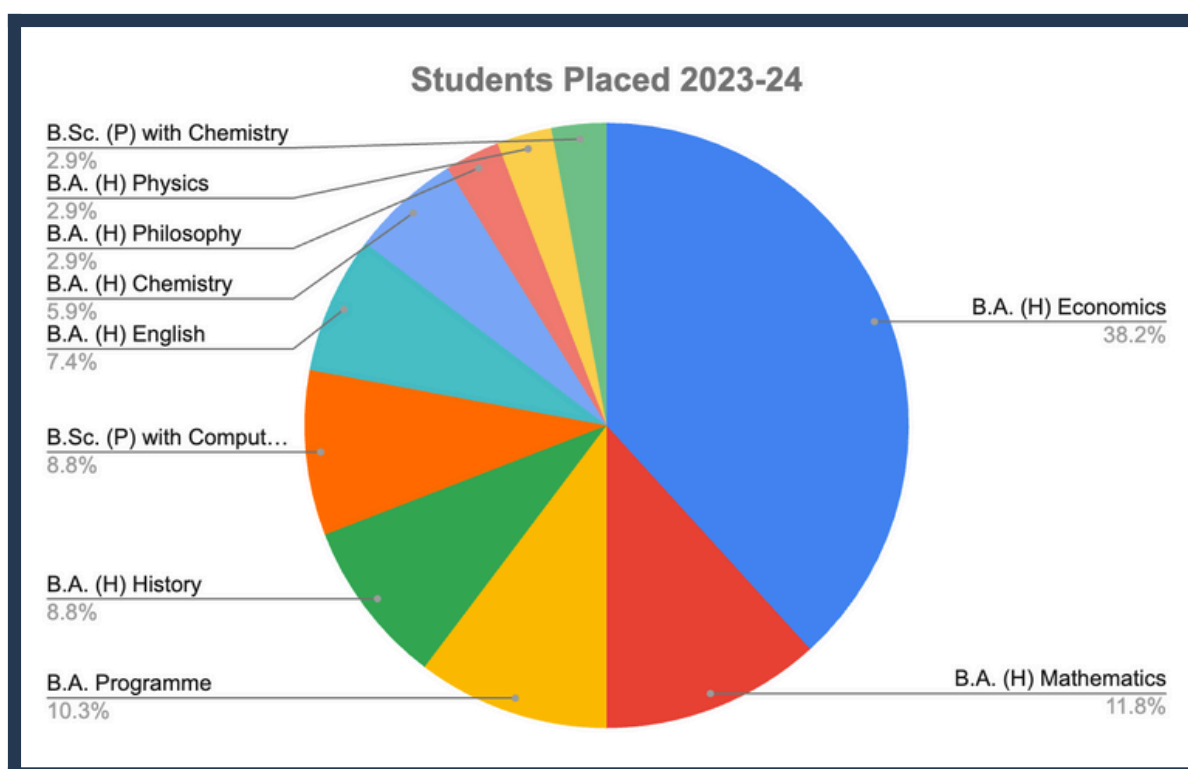

THE INTERNSHIP CONCLAVE

The Campus Placement Cell continuously endeavours to ensure that St. Stephen's College comes up with the best internship results and continues to be the most favoured destination for recruiting organizations.

What is the Internship Conclave?

St. Stephen's College was the first college in Delhi University to host an Internship Conclave with the aim of providing students and companies/organisations a platform for mutual growth. The Internship Conclave is held with the purpose of inviting firms to hire Summer interns.

Why should your firm participate?

The St. Stephen's College Internship Conclave invites firms ranging from Startups to MNCs to Fortune 500 and Social Organisations. We believe that by connecting our students to your organisation, we can foster long-lasting relationships and contribute to the growth of your organization.

When is Internship Conclave held?

The Internship Conclave is held all year round, except the time when the University examinations are being conducted. Students are available for Summer internships during the summer vacation as per the University guidelines.



SUMMER INTERNSHIPS

The Campus Placement Cell classifies all companies recruiting interns from the campus using a two-tier system, based on the stipend.

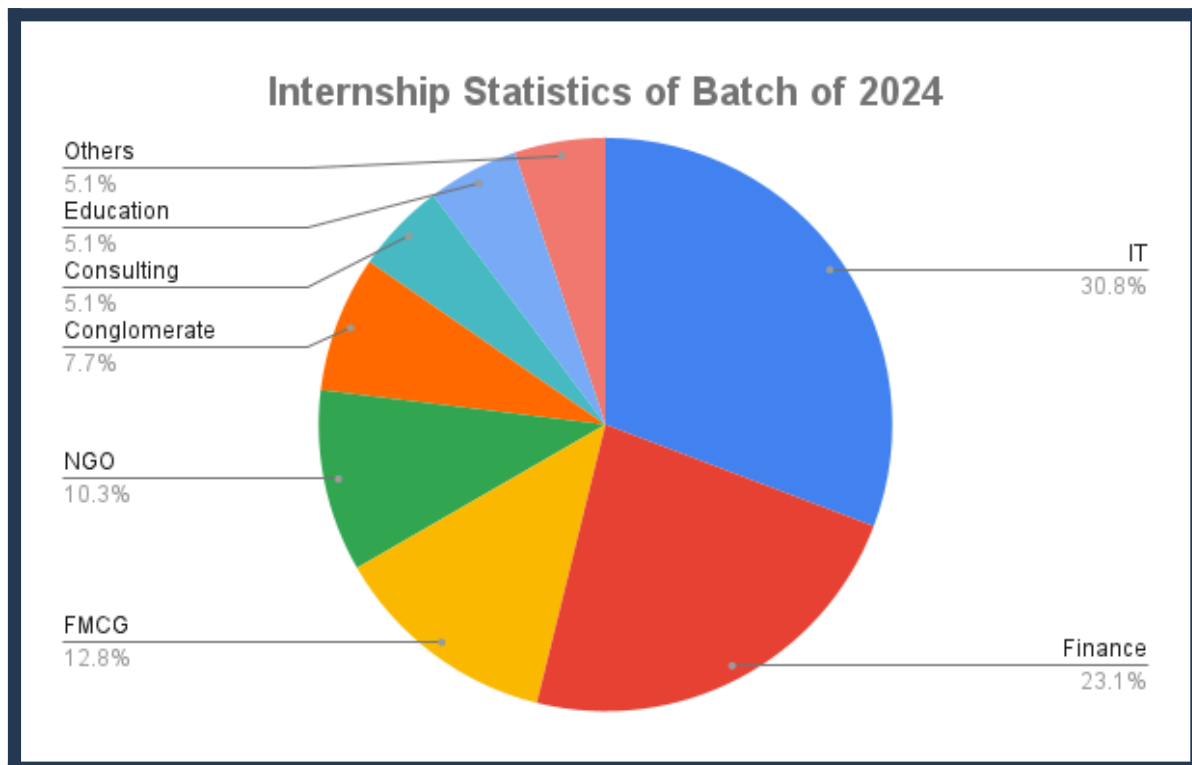
- **Tier- 1:** Companies/Organisations offering a stipend of more than or equal to Rs. 20,000 per month.
- **Tier -2:** Companies/Organisations offering a stipend of less than Rs. 20,000 per month.

Students are available for Summer internships only during the summer vacation as per the University guidelines. A student can do only one summer internship in an academic session.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1. What is the season for placements and internships at St. Stephen's College?

Our placement season is all-year round, except the time when the university examinations are being conducted.

The duration of the internship is dependent on the discretion of the company/organisation. For Summer internship, the majority of students are generally available in the summer vacations decided as per the University guidelines.

Q2. Who do I contact to recruit students from St. Stephen's College?

You can drop us a mail at cpc@ststephens.edu. Alternatively, you can contact one of our student placement coordinators directly (Contact details on the last page).

For further details of the recruitment procedure kindly refer to pages 9 and 10. The recruitment procedure for hiring interns is the same as final placements.

Q3. Will I have a particular point of contact in College for the recruitment procedure?

Yes. Every company/organisation is assigned a particular student representative from the Placement Cell who will help facilitate the recruitment process. He or she will be the link between the company/organisation and the College. The student representative can be reached on both email and telephone and will assist the recruiters at every stage of the recruitment process.

Q4. Can I contact the students directly as part of the recruitment procedure?



No. Kindly note that companies/organisations are not supposed to contact the students directly and all communication must be routed through the CPC.

Q5. What facilities are available to an on-campus recruiter?

Companies/Organisations have the freedom to conduct their recruitment process both on and off-campus. Our classrooms and Seminar Rooms are large, spacious, fully air-conditioned and Wi-Fi enabled and can be put to the companies'/organisations' disposal when they come on campus for placements. If need be, the College Hall can also be pressed into service for CPC requirements. Projectors for presentations and audio systems for talks being conducted are available in every room.

Q6. Is there any fee or surcharge that needs to be remunerated by a recruiting company/organisation?

Every company/organisation that comes on-campus for placements has to pay a nominal fee of Rs. 3500/event. Companies/Organisations that come on-campus for internships are charged a nominal fee of Rs. 2000/event (Tier 1 company) and Rs. 1000/event (Tier 2 company). No fee is levied on NGOs. No fee is levied on companies/organisations that opt for an off-campus placement process. The Campus Placement Cell accepts both cash and cheque payments. In the case of the latter, submission of copies of the PAN card and address proof of the account holder is also required. All cheques are to be made in the name of "The Principal, St. Stephen's College".

Q7. Can I conduct a recruitment process online?

The CPC places no restrictions on the format for the recruitment process(es). The companies/organisations can carry out their recruitment process(es) in whichever manner they see fit; the CPC will ensure that it is carried out smoothly and efficiently.
