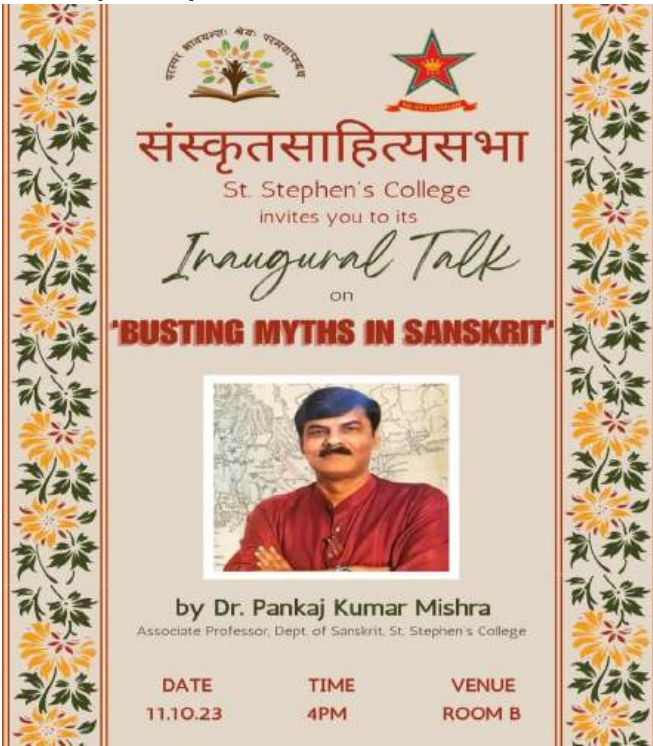
## Society Activity Report:

### Inaugural Talk on "Busting Myths in Sanskrit"

The inaugural talk was anchored by Arya (3<sup>rd</sup> Sanskrit Hons) & Aryesh (1<sup>st</sup> Sanskrit Hons). The event was started with thanking the almighty God (Manglacharan) by Palak Dangri (1<sup>st</sup> year) followed by felicitation by Surtarangini (3<sup>rd</sup> Sanskrit Hons). The event's speaker was Dr. Pankaj Kumar Mishra. Other senior members present at the event were Mr. Deepjyoti & Miss Monika.

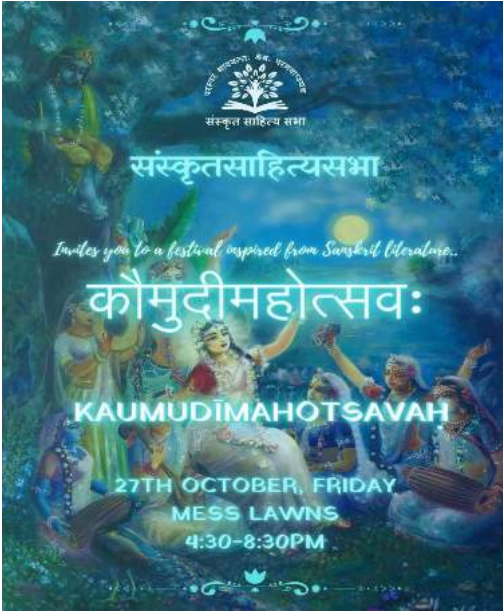


## Society Activity Report:

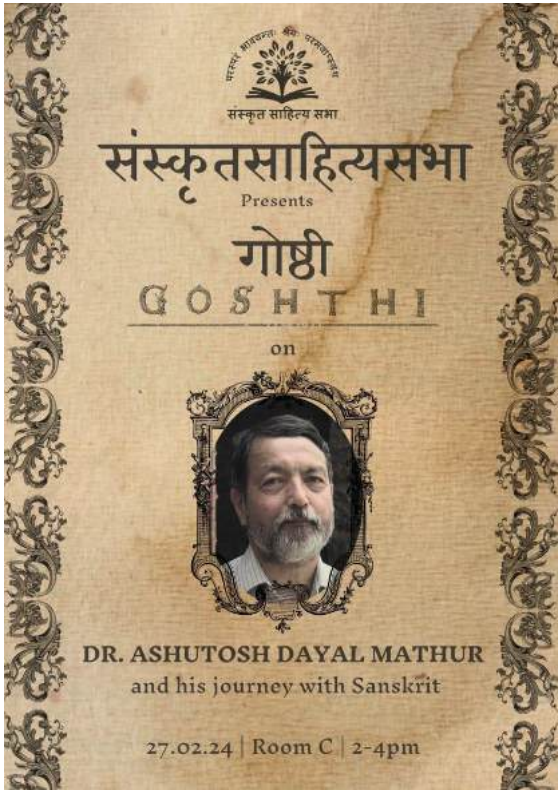


## Society Activity Report:
